

Town of Burns
January 13, 2021
Town Board Meeting Minutes

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Nuttleman at 7:28 pm. Roll call: Chairman (Chr.) Nuttleman, Supervisor (Sup.) Caulum, Supervisor (Sup.) Hoth, Treasurer (Tr.) Anderson, and Clerk (Clk.) Hart-Pollock present. Chairman (Chr.) Nuttleman noted the meeting was properly posted.
2. Tr. Anderson read the Treasurer's report for December 2020 available account balances total \$586,827.75 and Rockland Cemetery account balance is \$20,414.04. Chr. Nuttleman noted for the record that the December 2020 Treasurer's Report was received.
3. Motion by Sup. Hoth to approve the August 24, 2020 Public Hearing and Special Town Board and November 18, 2020 Special Town Board meeting minutes. Second made by Sup. Caulum. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.
4. Motion by Sup. Hoth to approve bills from December 8, 2020-January 13, 2021, checks #11190 and two EFTs from First National Bank. Second by Sup. Caulum. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.
5. Citizen Joe Cook inquired who he should contact in regards to selling land as he was not sure if it is the town board or zoning administrator.
6. Town Zoning Administrator Bill Larson reported the following:
 - Normal phone calls
 - Will meet with Joe Cook after his report.
7. There was discussion on the use of ATV and UTV's on township roads. There were five citizens from either Town Burns and Village of Rockland in attendance to speak in favor of the opening up the Town of Burns roads as the Village of Rockland permits ATV and UTV use in their municipality. Ole Mathison from the Village of Rockland suggests the Town of Burns to open up County Road J where Town of Burns begins from Village of Rockland to State Highway 16 and then open up Big Creek Road, Jewett Road, and Culpitt Road. The following concerns need to be addressed and looked into: signage expenses, time limits, speed limit, which roads to open up, preparing an ordinance, and how will the La Crosse County Sheriff's Department enforcing the ordinance. Chr. Nuttleman said we continue discussion at the next town board meeting.
8. There were no board member concerns.
