Town of Burns Resolution authorizing village powers (60.10 (2) (c))

The town meeting of the Town of Burns, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting at the annual town meeting or a special town meeting with notice assembled and voting, resolves and orders as follows:

Whereas the Town of Burns, La Crosse County, Wisconsin by a majority vote of the eligible electors voting at the January 8, 2013 special town meeting, recorded in the January 8, 2013 special meeting minutes, authorized the Town Board of the Town of Burns to exercise powers of a village board*, and

Whereas Pursuant to s. 60.10 (2) (c), Wis. stats., the Town Board of the Town of Burns is authorized to exercise powers of a village board under s. 60.22 (3), Wis. stats., which power shall be a general and continuing power for the Town Board of the Town of Burns.

The Town of Burns clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats., within 30 days of the below-noted adoption date.
