

Town of Burns
February 9, 2022
Town Board Meeting Minutes

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Nuttleman at 7:30 pm. Roll call: Chairman (Chr.) Nuttleman, Supervisor (Sup.) Caulum, Supervisor (Sup.) Hoth, Treasurer (Tr.) Anderson, and Clerk (Clk.) Hart-Pollock present. Chairman (Chr.) Nuttleman noted the meeting was properly posted.
2. Tr. Anderson reported the January 2022 treasurers report is unavailable at this time.
3. Motion by Sup. Hoth to approve the January 12, 2022 Town Board meeting minutes. Second made by Sup. Caulum. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.
4. Motion by Sup. Hoth to approve bills from January 13 – February 9, 2022, checks #11602-11636 and two EFTs from First National Bank. Second by Sup. Caulum. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.
5. There was no citizen concerns.
6. Wayne (Buck) Reynolds presented zoning maps of his and Sarah's property and of what he wishes to do with combining lots. Reynolds is requested a recreational easement to the La Crosse River and it will be approximately 21 feet wide. Chr. Nuttleman motioned to approve the 21 foot recreational easement for the current parcel of 3-732-0 to the La Crosse River. Second by Sup. Caulum. Voice vote, all ayes, motion carried.
7. Town Zoning Administrator (ZA) Bill Larson reported the following:
 - Cullman – per La Crosse County resident is requesting lottery credit. ZA Larson spoke with Pam at the County.
 - Ole Mathison – requested a CUP for a farm house.
 - K Jones – may move in a new mobile home.
 - Heitkamp – no changes, there is a foundation.
 - Warnke – no word.
 - T Green – inquired about building a livestock facility.
 - There are currently RVs/campers “squatting” on properties with people living in them.
8. Clk. Hart-Pollock reported that a draft ordinance is not completed. Hope to have for next meeting.
9. Discussed using some funds to repair the parking lot and COVID-19 bonuses for patrolman and recycling/refuse employees.
10. The new truck is almost done, will have it in 3 weeks.
